

Southeast District Horse Show Information – 2018

Kansas 4-H Horse Show Rule Book (S-133 Revised 2018) will be used for rule interpretations.

Exhibitors may show in only one Western Pleasure class, one Western Equitation class, one English Pleasure class, and one English Equitation class. No entries or changes will be made the day of the show, unless it is an entry error made in a) preparing the program, b) change of horse to another previously identified horse, c) error in the 4-H age of a participant, or d) error in horse type - stock type, non-stock type.

Proper Identification: A properly completed 4-H Horse Identification **must** be presented to the District Show entry clerk upon arrival for examination and to receive a contestant number. A 4-H'er can only show the same horse at the State Fair that was qualified at the District Show. **There will be NO exceptions.** A 4-H horse may be substituted between entry time and the District Horse Show, if the horse was properly identified by May 1. A 4-H'er must manage and care for the 4-H horse at least 75% of the time between May 1 and September 30. No animal or member may show in the same class twice.

Proof of Negative EIA (Coggins) Test must be presented for each horse at check-in. Horses without proof of this test will be required to leave the grounds immediately. Test must have been within the past 12 months. Other health papers are not required.

Classes for state show not requiring district qualifications are: Two Year Old Snaffle Bit – Phase 1, 2 (Interview) & 3, Three Year Old project, Level II, III & IV Horsemanship.

Accident Policy: Maximum medical insurance coverage for horse-related events is limited to \$500.

Appeal and Grievance Committee: All appeals must be submitted in writing before the next class has been completed. A \$25.00 cash fee must accompany each appeal which will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

District and State Participation

ALL AGES- youth who wish to participate at District and State horse shows must have successfully met the requirements of all three sections (knowledge, leadership, riding) of Achievement Level I **prior** to entry deadline - June 15th of the current 4-H year.

Show Date is Thursday, July 10, 2018. Registration starts at 7:30 a.m. Show starts at 9:00 a.m.

Location for the Southeast District Horse Show will be the Parsons State Hospital Arena, Parsons KS. The arena is located 1 mile south of the intersection of Hwy 400 and Ness Road (32nd street in Parsons) on Ness Road. There are signs on 400 signifying the Ness Road Exit and Parsons State Hospital.
